Any paper that been accepted or published in a peer-reviewed journal within the last 24 months before the start of the 17<sup>th</sup> European AIDS Conference, i.e. from November 1<sup>st</sup> 2017 on an HIV-related topic can be submitted.

If the paper has been co-authored by several authors, it should be made clear who of the authors is applying for the award. The application should be accompanied by a written declaration of all co-authors that they consent the application.
